It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor.. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first white settlers in Bothell.</p> <p align="center">IBU 60; 6.4 % ABV</p>
<p align="center">Knuckle Boom ESB</p> <p>With a round malty mouthfeel, this is an easy drinking amber ale.. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the *bitter* category.. *Knuckle Boom* is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm.</p> <p align="center">IBU 40; 5.8% ABV</p>	<p align="center">Four Ginger IPA</p> <p>Our Greenleaf IPA infused with 4 different types of ginger.: Galangal, Fresh, Pickled and Candied Ginger</p> <p align="center">IBU 60; 6.4% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Bastard Grain Pale Ale</p> <p>Orange citrus and tropical fruit aromas greet you on the nose with this pale and fruity NW style Pale Ale. This recipe features Alora hops in abundance and is sure to please all discerning pale ale lovers.</p> <p align="center">IBU: 35, ABV: 5.4%</p>	<p align="center">Jerry IPA</p> <p>Jerry IPA is a hoppy, NW style India pale ale that is ripe with flavor and aroma. Featuring Columbus, Amarillo, Citra and El Dorado hops. .A slightly sweet malt presence supports this mule of a hoppy beer. Speaking of mules, Jerry is named after a 922 lb Arkansas logging mule from the traditional *logging* song Timber (Ho).</p> <p align="center">IBU 70; 7.4% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Sequoia IRA</p> <p>Our IRA ~ India Red Ale ~ is hoppy like an IPA yet malty like an Amber Ale. Featuring only Centennial hops, this beer has a fantastic mouthfeel and a lovely hop aroma.</p> <p align="center">IBU: 50; ABV: 5.6%</p>	<p align="center">Knotted Porter</p> <p>Our robust Porter is dark & chocolaty with mild bitterness and low hop aroma which allows this malty chocolaty elixir to shine! Porters originated out of London and were named after the transport workers of the day that consumed a lot of the dark ales.</p> <p align="center">IBU: 32, ABV: 6.25%</p>
<p align="center">Magnolia Saison</p> <p>A farmhouse style ale that is spicy and fruity. Spicy from the French saison yeast, and fruit forward due to the addition of Citra hops and honey which imparts an orange marmalade character to this French / Belgian style ale.</p> <p align="center">IBU 30; ABV 6.9%</p>	<p align="center">Sidewinder Stout</p> <p>Dark and rich with bold roastiness, notes of roasted coffee and a hint of bittersweet dark chocolate. The American Stout is inspired from English & Irish Stouts, and were traditionally the generic term for the strongest or stoutest porters. *Sidewinder* is a limb or sapling that is bent under a tree that has been felled.</p> <p align="center">IBU 52; 7.1% ABV</p>
