It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, *Beaver Bait means *Loose Logs*. IBU 35; 5.3 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bad Axe IPA</p> <p>We use Columbus, Amarillo and Mosaic hops, and dry hop also with Amarillo and a touch of Mosaic to make this bright crisp NW style IPA burst with tropical notes and a long lasting finish. <p style="text-align: center;">Hoppy Hoppy Nelson Beer</p> <p>A standard Pale Ale [if you live in New Zealand !] Featuring lots of juicy fruit forward Nelson Sauvignon hops from down under as well a touch of local Sabro hops from Washington state. IBU: 38; 5.5% ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greenleaf IPA</p> <p>Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor.. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first white settlers in Bothell. IBU 60; 6.4 % ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Norway Hill Vienna Lager</p> <p>A German style lager named for the hill just South of Bothell. Brewed with Vienna malt and hopped with Super Galina and Kazbek hops, this sweet malt forward lager, and food pair together wonderfully! IBU 26; 5.4 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Springboard ISA</p> <p>Springboard ISA is the perfect summer ale for hopheads.. Flavorful and hoppy like an ipa but only 5.1% alcohol by volume, ISA (India Session Ale) is a sub-category of ipa's. this year featuring Washington Mosaic and New Zealand Nelson Sauvignon hops... IBU: 50, ABV: 5.1%</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Knuckle Boom ESB</p> <p>Malty & a bit spicy from the Tettnang hops, this is an easy drinking amber ale.. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the *bitter* category.. *Knuckle Boom* is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm. IBU 32; 5.9% ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Jager Porter</p> <p>This robust porter is dark and roasty with generous chocolate malt flavors, and low bitterness. *Hunter* (Jager in German) was named for Jack Yager; Winner of the 2018 Children's Fund auction item *Be Your Own Brewer at Beardslee*. IBU 38; 6.7% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Belgian Strawberry Blonde</p> <p>When Belgian monastic Westmalle yeast kisses El Dorado and Trident hops in a wort of Pilsner and Wheat malts, a beautiful Belgian Single is produced. When you then infuse over 7 lbs of Strawberries per keg: a sublime Belgian Strawberry Blonde is born. IBU: 26 ABV: 6.5%</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">R I S: Russian Imperial Stout (lite)</p> <p>This version of our R.I.S is less big, less bold, but just as beautiful. It is the *lite* version for Summer. Roasted barley, chocolate malt and a meaningful amount of crystal malt round out this bol'shoy mal'chik (Big Boy). IBU 66; 8.20% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Grapple Belgian Tripel *13oz tulip</p> <p>An American version of Belgian ale made famous by the monks in Belgium. On the palate notes of flint and orange marmalade mingle with the sweet ethanol and a luscious mouth feel. Featuring the subtle use of Czechoslovakian Saaz hops in this potent sipper..
