

<p style="text-align: center;">Beaver Bait Blonde</p> <p>An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, *Beaver Bait means *Loose Logs*.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 35; 5.3 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Multiplayer IPA</p> <p>A collaboration brew / fund raiser for the Washington Brewers Guild. Multiplayer was brewed by 47 Washington Breweries. *This IPA is a reflection of a connected and collaborative industry, working together to brew another day and pour another pint.* Lots of simcoe and Amarillo hops are featured in ours.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 52; 6.8% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Crosscut Kolsch</p> <p>Kolsch is a German golden ale that is made like an ale, yet stored cold like a lager. Last brewed in 2017, for this batch we used a different yeast strain, *Lutra*, the same yeast we use in our seltzer. Dry yet crisp, with low bitterness and a lingering malty finish.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 21; ABV 5.6%</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greenleaf IPA</p> <p>Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor.. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first settlers in Bothell.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 60; 6.4% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Ponderosa Pilsner</p> <p>Crisp, light, dry yet refreshing with medium bitterness, and pronounced malt and hop flavor.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 45; 5.1 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Knuckle Boom ESB</p> <p>Malty & a bit spicy from the Tettnang hops, this is an easy drinking amber ale.. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the *bitter* category.. *Knuckle Boom* is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 40; 5.8% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Mosaic Pale Ale</p> <p>Mosaic hops are featured in this North West style pale. This aromatic ale smells like mango juice mixed with papaya and apricot. Those flavors carry through on the palate with the added notes of orange and white grapefruit..</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU: 37; ABV: 5.9%</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Jager Porter</p> <p>This robust porter is dark and roasty with generous chocolate malt flavors, and low bitterness. *Hunter* (Jager in German) was named for Jack Yager: Winner of the 2018 Childrens Fund auction item *Be Your Own Brewer at Beardslee*.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 34; 6.2% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Cherry Sour Ale</p> <p>A kettle sour mash makes this light and refreshing ale that is aged with Montmorency tart cherries from Michigan. Both thirst quenching and delightfully refreshing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU: 12; 5.4% ABV PH 3.36</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Sidewinder Stout</p> <p>Dark and rich with bold roasty, notes of roasted coffee and a hint of bittersweet dark chocolate. The American Stout is inspired from English & Irish Stouts, and were traditionally the generic term for the strongest or stoutest porters. *Sidewinder* is a limb or sapling that is bent under a tree that has been felled.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 52; 7.1% ABV</p>
