

<p style="text-align: center;">Beaver Bait Blonde</p> <p>An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, *Beaver Bait means *Loose Logs*.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 35; 5.3 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Greenleaf IPA</p> <p>Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor.. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first settlers in Bothell.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 60; 6.4% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Ponderosa Pilsner</p> <p>Crisp, light, dry yet refreshing with medium bitterness, and pronounced malt and hop flavor.. The classic Summer beer.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 45; 5.1 % ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Citra Pale Ale</p> <p>Hoppy, citrus and tropical fruit aromas greet you on the nose with this pale and fruity NW style Pale Ale. This recipe features Citra Hops in abundance and is sure to please pale ale and IPA lovers.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 45; ABV 5.9%</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Dortmunder Lager</p> <p>A German style export lager. This style originated in the city of Dortmund and was popular with coal miners in the area. For our take on this style we used all Washington malt from Skagit Malting Co in Mt Vernon, and paired it with German Topaz and Hallertau Tradition hops.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU: 24 ABV: 5.8%</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Widow Maker Wit</p> <p>A Light, crisp & refreshing Belgian style wheat ale with orange peel and coriander. Wit means *white* describing the beer's pale color and cloudy appearance. Widow Maker is a logging term meaning a loose limb that may fall on a logger and make that logger's spouse a widow.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU: 16; 5.7% ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Knuckle Boom ESB</p> <p>Malty & a bit spicy from the Tettnang hops, this is an easy drinking amber ale. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the *special bitter* category. *Knuckle Boom* is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 40; 5.8% ABV</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Timburrrr Winter Ale</p> <p>Orange marmalade in color, yet crisp and fruity with a mouth watering light body, Timburrrr is a lightly spiced Winter warmer, featuring cinnamon, ginger and honey.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 45; 7.6 % ABV</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Wildwood Spirits Barrel Aged Magnolia Saison</p> <p>Our farmhouse style ale that is spicy and fruity. Spicy from the French saison yeast, and fruit forward due to the addition of Nelson Sauvignon hops which impart a white wine character to this French / Belgian style ale. Aged for 3 months in a Wildwood Spirits The Professor Coffee finished cask.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 26; ABV 6.5%</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Oatmeal Stout</p> <p>Smooth and silky and slippery on the tongue, this robust dark sipper finishes with a long lingering coco kiss.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">IBU 28; 7.8% ABV</p>
