

<p align="center">Beaver Bait Blonde</p> <p>An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, *Beaver Bait means *Loose Logs*.</p> <p align="center">IBU 35; 5.3 % ABV</p>	<p align="center">Greenleaf IPA</p> <p>Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor.. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first white settlers in Bothell.</p> <p align="center">IBU 60; 6.4 % ABV</p>
<p align="center">Crosscut Kolsch</p> <p>Kölsch is a German golden ale that is made like an ale, yet stored cold like a lager. Ours is brewed with an authentic yeast from Koln Germany Kölsch beers are characterized by a lightly fruity yeast note in aroma and taste, as well as a pleasant hoppy bitterness.</p> <p align="center">IBU 28; 6.0 % ABV</p>	<p align="center">Rye IPA</p> <p>You can smell the citrus and stone fruit from the Chinook, Cascade and Idaho 7 hops on the nose. On the palate, the rye shines through with a nice spice quality that adds complexity to a classic fruit forward NW style IPA with a spicy twist.</p> <p align="center">IBU 54; 6.7% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Mosaic Pale Ale</p> <p>Mosaic hops are featured in this North West style pale. This aromatic ale smells of mango mixed with papaya and apricot. Those flavors carry through on the palate with the added notes of bitter orange and white grapefruit..</p> <p align="center">IBU 42; ABV: 5.7%</p>	<p align="center">Multiplayer IPA</p> <p>Our Multiplayer IPA is a cold IPA, augmented with corn grit, fermented with Kolsch yeast, and serving up tropical flavors and 6.5% abv. Brewed with Citra and Zappa hops, yes these hops were named after Frank Zappa, and they are crazy good just like he was.</p> <p align="center">IBU 62 6.5% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Widow Maker Wit</p> <p>A Light, crisp & refreshing Belgian style wheat ale with orange peel and coriander. Wit means *white* describing the beer's pale color and cloudy appearance. Widow Maker is a logging term meaning a loose limb that may fall on a logger and make that logger's spouse a widow.</p> <p align="center">IBU: 19; 5.7% ABV</p>	<p align="center">Grapple Belgian Tripel *13oz tulip</p> <p>An American version of Belgian ale made famous by the monks in Belgium. On the palate notes of flint and orange marmalade mingle with the sweet ethanol and a luscious mouth feel. Featuring the subtle use of Idaho Gem and Kazbek hops in this potent sipper..</p> <p align="center">IBU 22; 9.3% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Knuckle Boom ESB</p> <p>Malty & a bit spicy from the Tettnang hops, this is an easy drinking amber ale.. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the *bitter* category.. *Knuckle Boom* is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm.</p> <p align="center">IBU 35; 5.9% ABV</p>	<p align="center">Sidewinder Stout</p> <p>Dark and rich with bold roastyness, notes of roasted coffee and a hint of bittersweet dark chocolate. The American Stout is inspired from English & Irish Stouts, and were traditionally the generic term for the strongest or stoutest porters. *Sidewinder* is a limb or sapling that is bent under a tree that has been felled.</p> <p align="center">IBU 52; 7.1% ABV</p>
<p align="center">Lime Pepper Kolsch</p> <p>As A treat for Cinco de Mayo, we made 2 kegs of our Crosscut Kolsch aged for a few days on Jalapeño, Serrano and Habanero peppers, along with some lime juice and zest. Pucker up for flavor!!!</p> <p align="center">IBU 28; ABV 6.0%</p> <p align="center">Coming soon:</p> <p align="center">Yellow Belly Wheat</p>	<p align="center">Brackett Scotch Ale</p> <p>Scotch Ales or "wee-heavy" are a sit-by-the-fire beer that pack a complexity of sweet malt and warming alcohol..flavors.
